

## یک پایه پل عام المنفع در ولسوالی تشکان ولایت بدخشان به بهره برداری سپرده شد

انکشافی سرک سازی آن توسط زون بدخشان برنامه ملی راه سازی روستایی تطبیق میگردد.



قبل از اعمار این پل مردم محل و مردمانی که از دور دست ها به این قریه رفت و آمد داشتند خیلی ها با دشواری و خطر مواجه بودند ولی با اعمار این پل مشکلات رفت و آمد مردم تا حد عظمی حل گردیده و تغییرات مثبت در زندگی اجتماعی و اقتصادی مردم رونما گردیده است. در ضمن اهالی منطقه از کارکرد این برنامه راضی به نظر میرسیدند و از برنامه جهت پایان بخشیدن به مشکلات شان تشکری کردند.

بدخشان یکی از ولایت شمال شرقی افغانستان است که در ۴۷۰ کیلومتری شهر کابل موقعیت دارد. این ولایت حدود ۱۸۰۰۰۰ تن باشنده دارد و پروژه های

این پل با ۲۵۰ متر سرک اتصالی در قریه سیدا اعمار شده است که حدوداً ۱۰۸۰ نفر بصورت مستقیم و ۱۳۵۰۰ نفر بصورت غیر مستقیم از مزایایی آن مستفید می شوند. کار اعمار این پروژه در ماه جدی سال ۱۳۹۶ آغاز و در اواخر ماه جوزا ۱۳۹۸ با هزینه مجموعی ۲۵۵۶۸۴۷۰ افغانی از بودیجه دولت توسط شرکت ساختمانی و سرک سازی پسران محمد نعیم تکمیل گردید.

## بازسازی یک سرک در ولسوالی خیرکوت ولایت پکتیکا

برنامه ملی راه سازی روستایی وزارت ترانسپورت ۱۰ کیلومتر از طریق سرک زرغون شهر خواجه خوا که ولسوالی های سرک که ۹ متر عرض سرک با شانه، ۷ متر عرض موتور، ۱۹ پایه پلچک و یک عدد ساختمان ۲۵ متره آب رو دارد و از منطقه زرغون شهر الی وازه خوا ولسوالی خیرکوت ولایت پکتیکا (بخش اول قسمت اول) ادامه دارد را تحت بازسازی قرار داده است.

سرک متذکره به ارزش ۱۹۳،۹۸۸،۰۱۴،۵۰ میلیون افغانی با شرکت ساختمانی با بر نبات امضا گردیده است و کاربازسازی آن عنقریب تکمیل خواهد گردید.

بازسازی این سرک در زندگی اقتصادی و اجتماعی اهالی منطقه تغییرات مثبت می آورد و در انتقال محصولات زراعتی به مرکز ولایت پکتیکا و دیگر مارکیت های مراکز ولایات و ولسوالی ها سهولت های بیشماری بوجود میآورد، همچنان در جریان تطبیق این پروژه زمینه های کاری قابل ملاحظه ای به اهالی منطقه فراهم گردیده و به طور اوسط روزانه ۴۰ نفر به گونه مستقیم به کار گماشته میشوند.

### Construction work of 12.6 Km road is inaugurated in East Region

National Rural Access Program of Ministry of Transport has inaugurated the construction work of 12.6 km road in an official ceremony.

The inauguration of the road was started in presence of Governor of Nangarhar, Sectorial and Public Works managers, Koz Kunar & Khas Kunar district attorneys and other officials. Mr. Shah Mahmood Myakhel, governor of Nangarhar while expressing his happiness added that four years ago, the construction work of 24 Km road was proposed but due to some problems it wasn't completed but today through Ministry of Transport the 12.6 Km road which starts from Kichri to Birkashkot construction is officially started. During the Ceremony, Engineer Mohammad Nazir Nangyal NRAP Head in East Region said that this project will be implemented with good quality and standardized in the Scheduled time.

Meanwhile, District Attorneys of Khas Kunar and Kuz Kunar, Malik Mohammad Ayoub, Haji Mohammaduddin, Ustad Ghafori nation's influencers and some other officials thanked from Nangarhar's governor and National Rural Access Program Management and were very happy that after four years the construction work of this road was started.

Afterward, Public Works Head Engineer Hamid said that they will monitor the construction work of this project in a very efficient way so that they could implement this project accurately.

The 12.6 Km road which has 8 meters width and 33 culverts in different sizes will connect Nangarhar & Kunar Districts after its construction and will bring enhancement in education, economic and other sectors of the community.

This road will be successfully implemented by Beltech Construction

Company with a total budget of 141000000 AFN from World Bank funds in nine months.

The Construction of this road also contains Retaining walls against floods which caused losses to landowners, evaluation of the previous implementor quality work, facilities in education, Health and other sectors.



### Construction of a 23.6 Rm Culvert in Tishkan District of Badakhshan Province

The National Rural Access Program of Ministry of Rural Rehabilitation and Development constructed a 23.6 meters box shaped culvert in Dasht Agha – Wakhshi Village road and put it into public use.

The 23.6 meters culvert construction work was launched by Mir Zaidullah Construction Company two years ago in January 2017 and is successfully completed in June 2019.

This project costed 27998335 AFN which was covered from Afghanistan Developing Budget and is successfully put into public use.

This is a box shaped culvert which addressed to many



problems of the residents and local residents also received benefits during construction phase, in this project 180 people directly and 16410 people were indirectly benefited and exclusively brought significant positive change.





### **A Welfare Bridge is constructed in Tashkan district of Badakhshan**

National Rural Access Program of Ministry of Rural Rehabilitation and Development recently constructed 44 Km Bridge in Tashkan district of Badakhshan province and put it into public use.

In the construction of 44 Km bridge with its 250 Km joint road in Sayeda village of Tashkan almost 1080 persons directly and 13500 persons indirectly were benefited.

The construction work of this project initiated in January 2017 and was successfully implemented by Pesaran Mohammad Naim Construction Company in June

2019 with total budget of 25,568,470.00 AFN from Afghan Government budget.

Prior to the construction of this project residents and people who came from very far colonies to this village faced lots of trouble and danger but through construction of this project the transportation problems of the community have been solved efficiently and made positive changes in social and economic lives of the people. Moreover, residents seemed very happy from NRAP activities and thanked the program for addressing to their problems.

Badakhshan is one of the North Eastern provinces in Afghanistan

which has 470 km distance from Kabul City. This province has around 1800000 residents and all of its rural development projects are being implemented under Badakhshan zone in National Rural Access Program.



### **Rehabilitation of a road in KhairKot District of Paktika Province**

National Rural Access Program of Ministry of Transport has started the rehabilitation of 10 Km road which has 9 meters shoulder width, 7 meters motorway, 19 culverts and a 25 meters waterway and is started from Zarghon City and continues to Waza Khowa (Part1, Lot1) in KhairKot district of Paktika Province.

The rehabilitation of this road has been signed with Babur Banat Construction company with total budget of 193,988,014.50 Afghanis which will be successfully completed in July.

Through this Road which connects Yahya Khel, Yousif Khel, Jani Khel and Waza Khowa districts to Paktika province and villages around Ghazni and

Paktia Provinces has created direct beneficiaries to 2500 from 20 villages and 25000 has received indirect beneficiaries till date.

Rehabilitation of this road has facilitated in social and economic lives of the residents particularly in transit of agricultural products to Paktika Province Markets and other markets in some provinces and districts. Furthermore, this project created lots of employment opportunities as in average 40 people are daily and directly recruited in this project.
